



Victorian Valance

This rod pocket valance can be used with a standard curtain rod or with a 2 1/2" continental rod. It can be made with or without a 2" header, with jabots or with simple returns. The elaborate headers are sleeves on a 2 1/2" continental rod, installed separately to hug the top of the valance. These sleeves can also be used to create beautiful window treatments on their own. **Valance depths are 16", 18", or 20"**.

Fabric Suggestions: Light to medium weight fabrics, soft and crisp fabrics. When finished, the horn sections flare out, exposing a little bit of the lining. You may want to plan a self or contrast lining for them and for the returns or jabots. A regular drapery lining should be used for the swag sections. Lace fabrics are beautiful for this valance. Line the lace with a soft sheer fabric such as batiste, voile or even a soft net as used for bridal veils.

YARDAGE

Decide how many swag sections you need. Fullness of **one swag section covers a span of 15" - 24" of rod space. Each jabot fills a span of 6"** on the face of the rod plus the projection.

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

Measurements given for swags and jabots include the 2" header. Swags are cut on the bias.

16" SWAG DEPTH

Jabot	the pattern is	33" wide x 34" deep
Return	the pattern is	13" wide x 22" deep
Swag	the pattern is	35" wide x 35" deep
Horn	the pattern is	17" wide x 15" deep

18" SWAG DEPTH

Jabot	the pattern is	33" wide x 35" deep
Return	the pattern is	13" wide x 24" deep
Swag	the pattern is	36" wide x 36" deep
Horn	the pattern is	18" wide x 17" deep

20" SWAG DEPTH

Jabot	the pattern is	33" wide x 37" deep
Return	the pattern is	13" wide x 26" deep
Swag	the pattern is	37" wide x 37" deep
Horn	the pattern is	20" wide x 19" deep

Same amount of lining will be needed.

SLEEVES

Rod sleeves are to be used with a 2 1/2" continental rod.

For about every 18" of rod space you need a width of fabric about 47" wide x 17" deep. Three widths are used here. For smaller sizes, eliminate the center. For larger sizes, add more center sections.



Victorian Rod Sleeve

For about every 18" of rod space you need a width of fabric about 47" wide x 18" deep.



Pouff Rod Sleeve

No additional fabric is needed for lining.

Yardage for trims:

Trims must be able to curve.

(maximum)	Each swag	24"
	Each horn	18"
	Each jabot	35"
	Each return	12"
