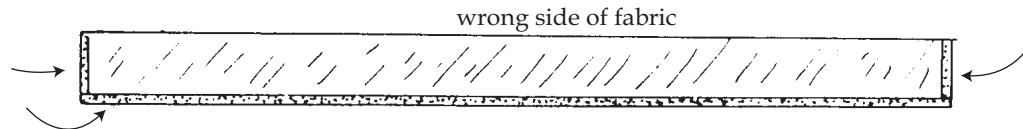


## TIP OF THE MONTH DECEMBER 2006

### HOW TO COVER POLES WITH FABRIC

Measure for the fabric to be deep enough to wrap around the pole and add 2". The fabric should also be 1" wider than the pole. (The width of the pole is horizontal of the window).

**Step 1** Press under 1/2" at each side and at one long edge of the fabric.



**Step 2** Draw a *straight* line across the top of the pole.

**Step 3** Put 1/2" double stick clear tape *straight* down the mark on the pole.

**Step 4** Place the unpressed edge of the fabric on the tape, with the right side of the fabric up. Make sure the ends of the fabric are neatly even with the ends of the pole.

**Step 5** Lift the pole up and let the fabric fall under it. Put a little white glue around the end edges between the fabric and the pole to hold them even.
