“OFF THE SHOULDER” INSTALLATION



The outside corners of this treatment drops down several inches from the top of the window. This idea can show off an interesting window and beautiful molding. In this case, an artistic bird.



CREATE A TRIM: I was unable to find a shell motif I liked for this unlined fabric. Therefore, I created one. I used a fabric glue to “sandwich” the raw edges of the fabric between two layers of gimp.

I could then glue the shells to the gimp as I pleased. Most of the shells were glued on while still on the work table. I used Fabri-Tac™ glue. A few others were glued on with hot glue after installation.

Imagine what other items you could use instead of shells to create *your* one of a kind trim.
