MITERING CORNERS OF BRAID AND FRINGE

Most braids and trims are turned 90 degrees at the corner with the excess tucked under to be flat.



Others may need to be slightly curved instead.

Sometimes it is attractive to allow the excess to jut upward, as shown.



This version has the excess brought to the front and folded flat at the front side.
